## **Chronology of Jerusalem**

2000 B.C.	Melchizedek, King of Salem (Jerusalem) brought Abraham bread and wine. Abraham offered Isaac on Mt. Moriah
1000 B.C.	David captured the city
961-922 B.C.	Solomon beautified the city and built the temple
800 B.C.	Uzziah
700 B.C.	Hezekiah
641-610 B.C.	Josiah
587 B.C.	City destroyed by Nebuchadnezzar of Babylon
539 B.C.	Persian occupation
520-516 B.C.	Zerubbabel's Temple
446 B.C.	Nehemiah rebuilds the walls
165 B.C.	Maccabeans
63 B.C.	The Romans captured the city
37 B.C.	Herod appointed King. He rebuilds the temple
41 B.C.	Herod Agrippa
70 A.D.	Destruction under Titus. Titus ploughed up a portion of Jerusalem
131 A.D.	Hadrian rebuilt the city and named it Aelia Capitolina
330-337 A.D.	Constantine the Great first 'Christian' emperor restored the name of Jerusalem
636 A.D.	Jerusalem passed to the Arabs who held it for almost 500 years

641 A.D.	The Persians conquered Jerusalem and destroyed all its churches
969 A.D.	Selzuk Turks
1099 A.D.	Crusaders
1187 A.D.	Saladin
1517-1917 A.D.	Ottoman Empire
1917 A.D.	Taken by the Allies under General Allenby, Balfour Declaration
1948 A.D.	State of Israel declared: <i>'There has always been and always will be one capital only, Jerusalem the eternal. Thus it was 3000 years ago and thus it will be, we believe, until the end of time.'</i> David Ben Gurion
1967 A.D.	Six-Day War. Jerusalem occupied by the Israelis
